- The cause is very significant Reasons:

- If most of the rivers/waters in the country is polluted, the waste would leak into the ocean which has 2 negatives:

1. marine animals will be poisoned, resulting in extinction of marine animals

2. The waste will go from the ocean into the nearby countries, resulting in the shortage of clean water in other countries
