- Students discussed the causes and effects of air pollution, and suggested ways to prevent and control air pollution.




Cause and effects of air pollution

- Avoid burning leaves, trash and other materials











Concave and convex lens:


- Subsequently, students drew the ray diagrams for the images formed by the convex lens.





- Subsequently, they drew the graphs using Jamboard.





曲的浅说

起源与别称

金、元以来受胡乐影响的新兴诗歌体裁,可以配合音乐演唱,盛行于元代,故称为"元曲"。由于元曲是从词演变而来的,所以也称"词余";因为可配乐歌唱,又称"乐府"。

体制与格津

- 1. 依据曲调填写,每个曲调都有名称,叫做"曲牌"。曲牌只标明曲子的音乐性,和内容无关,曲牌后面的题目才与内容有关,如《天净沙·秋思》中的"天净沙"是曲牌名,"秋思"是和内容有关系的题目。
- 2. 每个曲牌的句数、字数、平仄和押韵,都有一定的格式。在曲牌规定的字数之外增字,称为"衬字",用以补足语气,或描摹情感。此外,曲不避俗语俚语。

形式与类别

元曲分"散曲"和"戏曲"两类。

1. 散曲

只有曲文(歌词),而无科(动作)、 白(独白或对话),仅可歌唱,和词 的性质相近。分:

- (b) 散套:又称"套数""套曲",用同宫调两支以上(可多达数十支)的小令组成,自成首尾,前后连贯。"宫调"类似现代音乐中所说的"调",如G调、D调等。

2. 戏曲

戏曲又分杂剧和传奇两种。

(a) 杂剧: 又称"北曲",盛行于元,

- 除曲文之外,还有科、白,是以歌唱为主,配合动作 和说话来搬演故事 的戏剧。一幕谓之 "一折",每剧限
- 的戏剧。一幕谓之 "一折",每剧限 四折,仅旦、末的 独唱;每折限一宫 调,一韵到底。


